

## YARD WASTE

Allied Waste will provide collection of grass clippings, twigs, leaves and various other plant materials between the first week in April and the final week of November.

(1) 30-gallon paper yard waste bag or  
(1) securely tied bundle of brush not exceeding four (4) feet in length and two (2) feet in diameter is included with the weekly pickup. *Yard waste contained in plastic bags or trash cans is not allowed and will not be picked up.* The maximum weight of any item is 50 lbs.

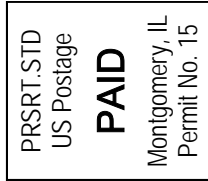
Additional yard waste items require the purchase and attachment of a waste sticker. Waste stickers are available at the Village Hall and at local merchants listed on the inside of this brochure.

Natural Christmas trees without ornamentation will be collected at no additional cost during a two week period following Christmas.

## SPRING & FALL CLEAN-UP

Special clean-up service will be provided in the spring and fall of each year. The exact dates will be announced in the Village newsletter and local newspapers.

During Spring and Fall Clean-up, unlimited amounts of garbage, yard waste and household items may be disposed of without attaching stickers. Each household may also dispose of up to four tires and one cubic yard of construction materials.

## GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Village provides its residents with a modified volume-based waste collection program through its contractor, Allied Waste. This means that residents are allowed to dispose of a specified amount of household, recyclable and yard waste each week for a monthly fee. There are additional fees for volumes of waste that exceed the limits.

All waste materials must be placed at the curb prior to 6:00 a.m. on the pickup day.

Collection will not be provided on the following holidays:

New Year's Day  
Memorial Day  
Independence Day  
Labor Day  
Thanksgiving Day  
Christmas Day

On holiday weeks, collection will be provided one day later than usual.

Household, recyclable and yard wastes are collected in different vehicles on separate routes. Pickup times may vary for each service. For example, household waste may be picked up much later in the day than recyclable waste.

Seniors 65 and older may purchase specially priced 14-gallon trash bags as a less costly option than paying the monthly charge. This program is available through registration at the Village Hall.

Backdoor service is available to seniors and residents with disabilities through special arrangements for an additional fee. Please contact the Village Hall at (630) 896-8080 ext. 33 for additional information.

## HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Allied Waste Services will provide weekly collection of:

- (2) 33-gallon cans or 40-gallon plastic bags of refuse, not to exceed 50 lb. each
- Unlimited recyclable waste
- (1) 30-gallon paper yard waste bag or (1) bundle of brush

Every item that does not fit into a trash container, such as an appliance, furniture, mattress, etc., will require the purchase and attachment of a waste sticker to authorize collection personnel to pick it up.

*Household construction waste that can be bundled not to exceed four (4) feet in length by two (2) feet in diameter will also be picked up with a sticker attached.*

## RECYCLABLE WASTE

Collection of unlimited amounts of the following types of recyclable materials is provided weekly. All materials may be placed together (unsorted) in the same clearly marked plastic recycling container, including:

### PAPER ITEMS

Examples include newspapers, magazines, catalogs, telephone directories, paper bags, paper food and beverage packaging, advertising fliers, mail, corrugated cardboard and all other paper items.

### FOOD & BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

**Plastic Items:** Examples include milk jugs, soda and water bottles, laundry and dish detergent bottles, butter tubs, yogurt cups, shampoo bottles and others.

**Metal Items:** Examples include aluminum beverage cans, bi-metal beverage and food cans, steel cans, empty aerosol cans and many other types of containers used within the household.

**Glass Items:** Examples include all colors of bottles and jars used for beverages and food storage.

**Other Items:** Examples include gable top milk and juice cartons and beverage (juice box) cartons made of mixed materials.

*Please note that containers used for vehicle fluids like motor oil, coolant & gasoline, pool chemicals and other hazardous & flammable chemicals are not acceptable due to the danger to waste collection and handling personnel.*

One recycling bin is provided for each household. This bin is the property of the Village and must be left at the home if a resident moves. Additional bins are available for purchase at the Village Hall.
