Minutes

Intergovernmental Committee Meeting

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.
- II. **Roll Call:** Present were Matt Brolley, Dan Gier, Doug Marecek, Denny Lee, Steve Jungermann, Penny FitzPatrick, Armando Sanders, Debbie Buchanan, Pete Wallers, Corinne Vargas, and guests. Tom Betsinger and Mark Wolf arrived at 6:10 p.m.
- III. **Minutes of October 28, 2019 and November 5, 2019:** Steve Jungermann moved to approve the minutes of October 28 and November 5, 2019, seconded by Doug Marecek. Motion carried 5-0.
- IV. **Items for Discussion**
 - A. Montgomery Fest
 1. 2020 Montgomery Fest Bands—Various bands were reviewed and approval was given for Kovacs and Evil Burrito. Red Wanting Blue charges \$10,000 which was considered too expensive.
 2. Stage—Corinne Vargas has investigated and brought information on a possible stage to use. Committee members asked for information on how high off the ground the stage would be and what is the height. May be necessary to remove a tree or trim branches.
 3. Other Entertainment/Events—The committee requested the BMX Bike Show and also rescue animals in 2020.
 4. Marketing and advertising for the Fest was discussed briefly.
 - B. Senior Lunch Program—Dan Gier presented information on the senior program, including entertainment, lunch and revenue/expenses. He suggested we try to get more free programs. He will handle room set up and will make a supply run monthly to get dessert and drinks to minimize staff time. He also plans to change the room set up to make more space and clean out the storage room. He is confident we can make the program work at Village Hall, since moving to Riverview Restaurant would increase the cost. Dan said the seniors prefer to stay here and keep the cost at \$5.

Going forward, the Community Relations Manager will book the entertainment and get businesses to sponsor or donate for Bingo. He will need someone to pick up food but not serve food. He recently received a donation of \$500 from Bank of Montgomery and expects to get that annually.

It was proposed to cancel the lunch in January and February due to the weather, but after discussion it was decided to keep it because they need to get out in the winter. Dan emphasized that the program is open to the whole community and it needs to be marketed as two separate events. He wants separate press releases for the entertainment and the lunch. Costs were also discussed. Dan would like to do a full year and revisit costs before making any change.

- IV. Adjournment:** Doug Marecek moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Steve Jungermann. Motion carried 6-0. The meeting was adjourned at 6:52pm.
